# Year 3

- Reading "The Wild Way Home", a fantasy adventure story set in the Stone Age.
- Exploring All About Me and thinking how we can progress towards what we want to be as we grow up.
- On Friday 27th September Year 3 can dress up to represent what they want to become in the future.



#### Year 4

- Reading "Toto the Ninja Cat" and "The Secrets of the Sun King" in class.
- Starting to learn about rivers in geography and finding out about Ancient Egypt in history.
- Discovering different habitats on our adventures to Trenance Gardens, local rock pools & Newquay Zoo.



## Year 5

- Beginning our journey of space exploration as our main topic this term.
- Reading "The Kid that came from Space", an exciting adventure about a sibling rescue, set in space.
- Float to live sessions have been taking place for Year 5, building water confidence and sea safety.
- On Weds 16<sup>th</sup> Oct, we will be visited by the Space Dome to take part in our own solar system experience.



# Year 6

- Reading "A Twist in the Tale", imagining what might have happened if Oliver Twist had a twin sister.
- Studying rivers in geography and reading "Flooded", an illustrated book about the impact of flooding.
- Writing a report based on a public enquiry into the flood. This is inspired by the book we have read.
- Creating our own artistic designs based on the print work of William Morris in art.
