An overview of the activities coming up in each year group:

Year 3 – Ancient Greece, Myths & Legends:



- Reading 'Mark of the Cyclops' by Saviour Pirotta; a who-dunnit novel set in Ancient Greece.
- Exploring 'Mythologica' by Steve Kershaw, a beautiful reference book about Greek mythological gods.
- Creating our own Healthy Eating Plate in Science and discovering what Ancient Greeks ate.
- Understanding how historians used evidence to find out so much about how the Ancient Greeks lived.
- In PE we are swimming and doing Athletics, inspired by records set by the first Ancient Greek Olympians!

Year 4 - Questions and Quests:



- Reading 'Kensuke's Kingdom' by Michael Morpurgo, a magical adventure story about friendship and survival.
- Writing inspired by the 'Mermaid of Zennor', a mythical legend about mermaids in a Cornish village.
- Learning about States of Matter in Science, discovering the properties of solids, liquids and gases.
- Exploring Wild Weather in Geography.
- Practising for the Year 4 Times Table Check in June by using Times Table Rock Stars!

Year 5 – Changes and Differences:



- Reading 'Asha and the Spirit Bird' by Jasbinder Bilan, as our reading book in class.
- Exploring 'The Island' by Armin Greder, discovering what happens when a mysterious stranger arrives.
- Taking part in the Year 5 Camp or the Year 5 Activity Days during this week.
- We are also looking forward to learning some African drumming skills, working as a class team, over this term.

Year 6 - Coasts:



- Year 6 have been making their final preparations for SATS, practising their English, Maths and GPS.
- Reading 'Holes', where children are told to dig holes in the desert, but is there a mysterious reason behind it all?
- Developing our skills in Athletics, ready for the Summer Olympic Sports Days in July.
